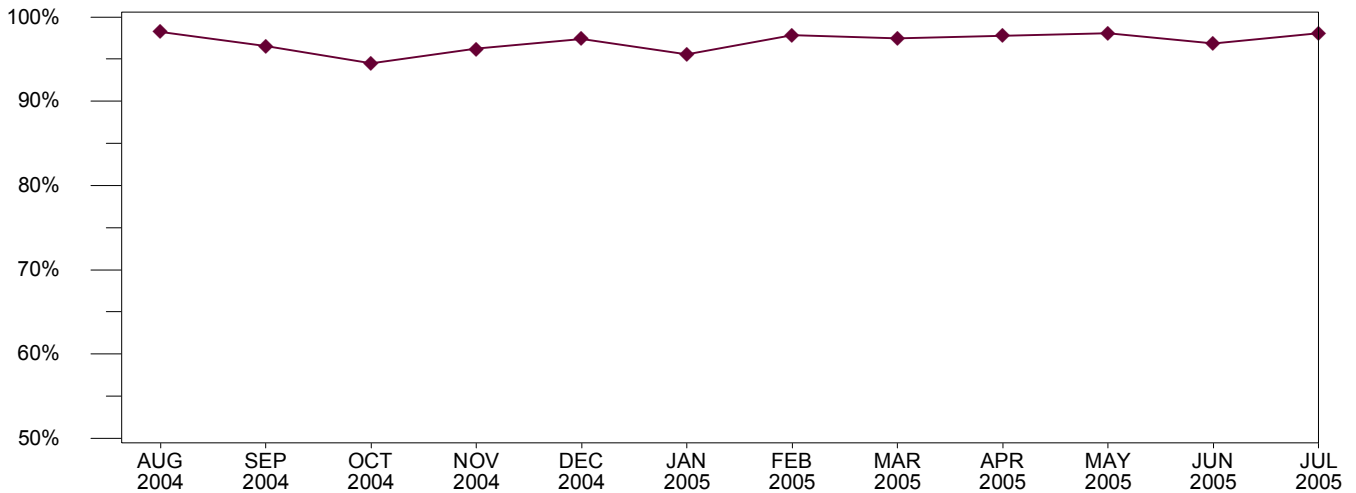

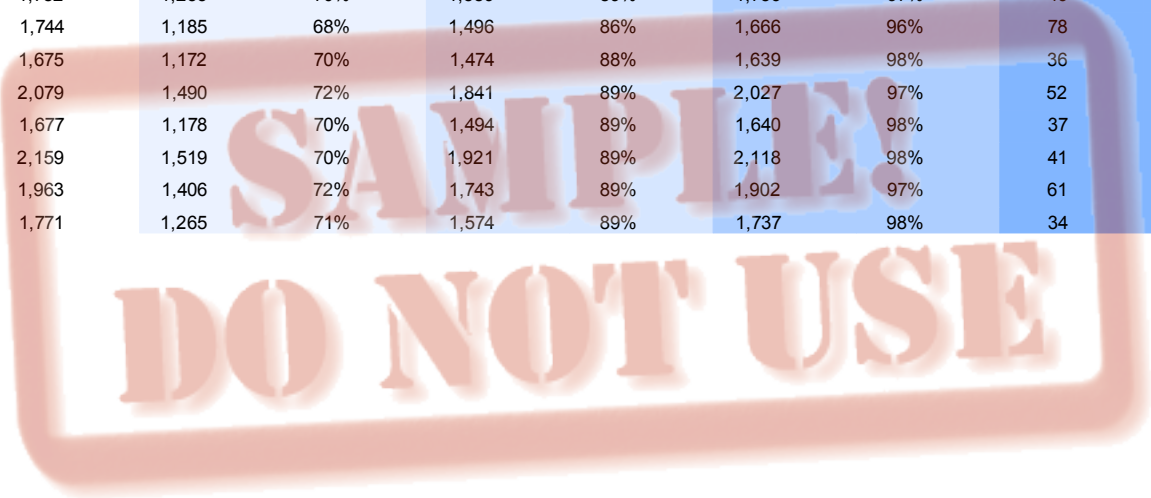


Offense cases include: Felonies and Misdemeanors Combined
